



### **Abstract Submission Guidelines**

- All abstracts submitted before the short talk deadline will be considered for both a short talk and poster presentation.
- One abstract per meeting per person.
- No duplicate abstracts accepted for a standalone or joint meeting.
- The submitter is also the presenter, if chosen for a short talk.
- No comments or image boxes in the text of the abstract.
- Abstract title in title case.
- All abstracts submitted for a short talk, poster presentation, and scholarship are reviewed by the meeting scientific organizers and acceptance is based on scientific content and relevance to meeting topics discussed in the program.
- \*\*Consideration for short talk, poster presentation, and scholarship requires the authors and their affiliations to be included in the Text field above your abstract, with a limit of 500 words.

We will reach out via email regarding Abstracts that do not meet our formatting guidelines.
